3. Students Council Update: Madeleine and Caleb

- Caleb: Council has been working hard to give the students something to look forward to in each octomester. The focus this month has been on Christmas and they have tried to think outside the box to plan activities to involve all (in-person and online) students

- The Specialist High Skills Major (SHSM) courses in Communication Technology and Environmental Studies are currently running, but virtually. Grade eleven students are currently being recruited for next year.
