4. Students Council Update: Madeleine and Caleb

- Caleb, head boy: Grade 9 day took place and went well. Council tried their best to give them a good experience and it was very successful.
- Virtual talent show in 3 weeks: HC's GOT TALENT- Will be live on YouTube channel
- Madeline, head girl: spirit wear- new designs coming! Flash sales!
- Main goal- welcoming and inclusive community and want everyone to feel comfy. Want to make sure they reach remote learners too.
- 5. Pastoral Report: Nick Cotman
  - No mass for now
- 6. Principal's Report: Mike Faught
  - Good start to the new year! They missed a lot of events but wanted to make sure grade 9s felt welcome and at ease. They were kept in their cohorts but participated in welcome events.
  - Grade 10s came for day two
  - All grades present on Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup>
  - Octomester- all day period one class, 22 days
  - Staggered lunch and breaks for all
  - Very different vibe in the school. Always just a few people in the halls, no big rush like they're used to
  - Working fairly well. Teachers already tired- new schedule is tough for them too
  - Very important to meet kids where they're at and find the pace that works to relieve stress and keeps them motivated but keeps them moving forward at the same time.

- They're trying to normalize things as best as they can to get students back on track
- Social distancing is tough- daily reminders over PA- Mr. F getting many calls from community with distancing alerts and reports.
- 7. Student Generated Funds Report: Alida French and Susan Pereira Nothing to report tonight
- 8. Teacher report: Jennifer McDonald
  - Council kids are amazing!
  - Staff and administration are really stepping up. They're absolutely doing the best they can- embracing technology and finding creative ways to support the school community
  - Student council sent out surveys to ask about first week and highlights: The results from grade 9s showed 4 out of 5 starsamazing experience so far and some really, nice comments came in.
- 9. Community Report/Public Health: Lisa Lollar
  - Nothing will be perfect! They've been working hard to get messages out, but almost immediately, things change and new information is coming in
  - It will get better!
  - Right now, 5 active cases in the Kingston community
  - Lisa is helping to open Queen's testing centre but also helps at the Leon's centre
  - They're struggling to get Queen's students on board

- Need to find a way to get people really invested in the cause and communicating the issues with their kids
- Outdoor time is a challenge. It's safer, but there are still dangers
- Wear your masks!
- Mr. Faught says that there's about 99.9% mask compliance inside the school but the hardest part seems to be kids coming and going to/from the bus
- Approx. 70 kids can be on a bus. Kids should be wearing masks on the bus too
- Patti- asked about the protocol for kids that show symptoms. Lisa says to use the screening tools for schools that can be found online. There's a slightly revised version coming out.
- Public Health has a pro-testing attitude. There is nothing else that
  can distinguish a common cold from COVID. If they get a negative
  test, they can come back when their symptoms have improved
  over 24 hours and they no longer have a fever. If they won't get
  tested, they need to stay home for 14 days. Last option is to reach
  out to family doctor and have them confirm non-COVID diagnosis
  and have them recommend the student goes back to school
- Testing are long but it's good to get a baseline (in cases where child has illness like allergies), then watch for systems are different or more severe.
- Protocols: School community stays home when they're sick, hand hygiene, physical distancing, mask wearing, enhanced cleaning
