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SFA Book Fair & The Amazing Race Family Dr. Seuss Night January 23rd to January 25th

Note: I was going to run "Oh, the places you'll go" Breakout EDU game but that was run in the 3-5 community in September. I am reworking a Dr. Seuss themed game using several Dr. Seuss books.

Weeks leading up to Book Fair/Amazing Race

- Reading a variety of Dr. Seuss books to classes.
- Dr. Seuss themed Activity and Colouring sheets will be distributed to Teachers.

Monday, January 22nd

- Scholastic Book Fair arrives at SFA.
- Set up Monday evening in Da Vinci Studio if this works for Parent Council.
- If not, Janice will set up on Tuesday morning.

Tuesday, January 23rd and Wednesday January 24th

- Classes visit the Book Fair
- Make wish lists.

Thursday, January 25th – During school hours.

• Students can purchase books/items if they brought money.

Tuesday, January 23rd to Thursday, January 25th

- Scholastic provides 6 Golden Ticket give-aways worth \$10.00 each.
- This can only be spent at the Book Fair.
- During morning announcements on these days a Dr. Seuss quote will be read.
- A station will be set up by the front desk where students can come and fill in a ballot to guess which Dr. Seuss book the quote is from.
- 2 Golden Ticket winners will be drawn per day.
- They can then spend the ticket on Thursday or at the Family Literacy Night.

The Amazing Race Family Dr. Seuss Night

(I am open to suggestions for a title for the night)

6:00 PM - Arrival - Gathering Stairs

- Dan/Chris/Melissa greet families.
- I will have a slide show set up for every stage of the program.
- Dan, Chris or Melissa reads Oh, the Places You'll Go! Book will be projected on the screen as well.

6:15 pm - Explaining the Breakout EDU Game

- Packages for each team. Each package contains:
 - O Schedule of the night and Rules of the game
 - Map of school
 - O Passport (receive stickers at each completed station)
 - o First Clue
- The game is 45 minutes long. An official time clock will be set on the screen at the gathering stairs.
- The game consists of 5 locked boxes. I will have a duplicate set of boxes at each station in case there is a large number of participants. It will keep the game moving.
- There will be five stations:
- 1. The Cat in the Hat
- 2. Horton Hears a Who!
- 3. Yertle the Turtle
- 4. Oh, the places you'll go!
- 5. Green Eggs and Ham

The stations will be located around the school and marked on the map.

Game will start between 6:15 pm and 6:30 pm. The exact time it starts is not an issue but it will only run for 45 minutes.

- All teams meet back at the Gathering Stairs when finished or time is up.
- For teams finishing early have a digital puzzle on ipads. The Puzzle will be Dr. Seuss images with the message "Thank you for coming! SFA Parent Council and Staff". This will be posted on the screen when all the teams are seated.
- Draws for prizes by SFA Parent Council.
- People can go to the Book Fair to shop. We plan on clearing the school by 7:45 pm.

Please note: The Book Fair will be open and staffed during the time of the game for people who just want to shop.

Volunteers Required:

- 5 volunteers **minimum** to be at each station. (written instructions will be provided).
- 2 volunteers for Book Fair on Thursday night.
- Volunteers for Book Fair on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday during the day.
