a. PRO Grant

- Chris applied for the PRO Grant. The responses to the survey are below:
 - Describe your proposed project and explain how it meets with one (or more) of the desired outcomes described on the PRO Grant Memo.
 - At St. Francis of Assisi Catholic School, we've identified our Equity Goal as follows: "We will use the resilience building blocks to build the capacity of our students to be resilient (i.e., emotionally health and equipped to successfully confront challenges and bounce back from setbacks) to mitigate and overcome the impacts of trauma and toxic stress on their brains, leading to improved learning and long-term life outcomes." We have developed and implemented a systematic plan to build resiliency in our students by focusing on each of the 42 resiliency building blocks, connected to a particular theme each month (e.g., Relationships, Belonging, Regulation, etc.). To come full circle, we will partner with Kingston Community Health Centre to provide a parent/guardian night (evening presentation) that speaks to how building resiliency can mitigate and overcome the impacts of trauma and toxic stress on the brain, leading to improved long-term life outcomes for all. This project will meet the following outcomes in the memo: i) Parents have increased awareness of school activities and initiatives, ii) Parents experience fewer barriers to participation in their child's education, iii) Parents understand how to address local needs and systemic barriers in the school community, and iv) Parents are provided with the knowledge, skills, and tools they need to support their child's learning at home and at school.
 - o What quantity of funding are you seeking?
 - We are requesting \$2500.
 - Explain specifically what the funds will be used to support (you will be required to submit receipts - so please save them).
 - These funds will be used to cover the cost of the speaker, refreshments, print resources, books for attendees, advertisement/print materials.
