





If you do not pass the provincial screening tool, follow the provincial instructions provided, including what siblings and other people you live with should do.

Does the student, staff or visitor have one or more of the following symptoms?

						
Sore throat	Difficulty swallowing	Runny or stuffy nose	Abdominal pain	Headache (unusual or long lasting)	Conjunctivitis (pink eye)	Decreased or lack of appetite

If you answered **YES** to any of the symptoms above, do **NOT** attend school until your symptoms are improving for at least 24 hours. A COVID-19 test is strongly recommended for the symptomatic person. Siblings and other people you live with do not have to isolate while the symptomatic person waits for their test result.

KFL&A region's COVID-19 assessment centres offer a less invasive swab test for children to help ease the testing experience for them. Please be sure to request a less invasive swab for your child's COVID-19 test.
